I believe that I have the information you need to fill the voids. Ann Eliza Klock was called Ida by her parents. James G and Sallie Klock. Ida was born in 1850 and married my great-grandfather Joel Rice Bennett on Dec. 1,1875. Joel R. Bennett was born Jan 1, 1854 in Waterloo Iowa. Theirs was obviously a rocky marraige from the beginning with disapproval from her parents. He left shortly after their first child, Elsie Bennett(Hamburger) was born Dec. 12,1876. He reconciled long enough to produce their second daughter Gertrude b. April of 1879. Soon after, a divorce was obtained for Ida by her parents. Why the marraige did not succeed is mere speculation on my part but it may have been due to his philandering and mental cruelty. I do know a lot about his ancestory which is quite extensive. Both of his parents had Native American ancestory along with a pedigree going back to the 1st century C.E. in Europe. Joel R. Bennett's second wife died under mysterious circumstances and his third wife was my great grandmother Josephine Bequette who was nearly full-blooded Illiniwek (Native Am.) Their oldest daughter Hazel was my grandmother. But back to the Klock family, yes, Ida Klock married James Merril and had a son James Merril. Ida Klock(Bennett)Merril is buried at the cemetary in Chico Ca., along with her James Merril and her daughter Elsie Bennett Hamburger. I have been there and photographed the graves. Elsie Bennett Hamburger had four children by Isaac Hamburger, Lewis (1906-2003), Nancy (1908-1986), Elsie Mae (1911-2003), and Helen(1915-1994). Lewis and Nancy had no children. Elsie Mae had one son, Robert Kitteridge who lives in Woodland Ca, and Helen had two daughters, Kay and Kirsten Krueger, both still living in Ca. Gertrude Bennett married Charles Sowder in 1902 and they had two children, Rev. Charles Sowder and James. I have photo of James and his wife Marie. They lived in Santa Cruz Ca. I mentioned the book by Elsie Hamburger, "I Never Look Back", which was written by Lois Halliday McDonald, whom I've met and talked family with just 2 years back. There is extensive information in that book about this side of the Klock family that you would find very interesting. I bought the book on line for a couple of bucks.. I highly suggest you try and get it as it contains a wealth of info on the Klock family. The book contains many photographs. I hope that I may have been helpful in filling the gaps.

Marvin was born in Millington, Michigan on April 23, 1874, the third child of Elon M. and Diantha (Klock) Waters. At the age of 4 he moved with his family to New York.

In 1900 he was a cheesemaker, living in the town of Turin. On Christmas Day, 1901in Lowville he married Gertie Fuller, daughter of Eugene and Alice [Edick] Fuller. By the year 1910 they had 6 children, Majel B. born December 10, 1902, Margaret C. born 1904 and died young, George A. born January 20, 1905, Eugene E. born April 5, 1907 and Alice E. born January 25, 1909. Marvin was a dairy farmer and the family was living in Lowville, New York.

Sometime between 1910 and 1920 the family moved to Dolgeville, Herkimer County, New York. At that time Marvin worked at the shoe factory as a ribbon stringer. They had two more children, Horace born 1909 and died in 1914 and Shirley born 1916.

By 1930 he and his family had moved to 274 East Clark Street in Ilion, Herkimer County, New York and he was working as a repairman for the typewriter factory.

All the children had left home except Shirley.

During the 40's and 50's he owned a farm in Pulaski. On the farm he raised mink, made and sold dairy products and what ever they could to make a living. He had a old Maxwell that he took to the feed mill and filled the it to capacity between the front and rear seats. Finally the old maxwell broke one to many times and he buried it on the farm piece by piece, saying it was no good to anyone. He sold the farm in 1959 and they lived part time with his daughter Alice in Woodville and the rest of the time with his son George. He was a member of the Masons.

Marvin passed away July 2, 1959 of Congestive Cardiac Failure at the home of his son George in Durhamville, NY. At the time of his death he was a retired cheesemaker for the John Muller Creameries. He is buried at the Dugway Cemetery with his wife Gertie, his son George, his wife Blance and two of their children, his daughter Majel and her husband Kenneth.

Alice M Klock married Isaac Carlton of Saginaw, MI abt. 1901, they lived in Saginaw and had four sons, Harold b.1903 (my grandfather), William b.1907, Francis b. 1910 and Thoral b. 1913. The family moved from Saginaw to Detroit sometime between the 1920 and 1930 census. The 1930 census shows Fanny (age 80) living with Alice and Isaac in Detroit. Isaac died in 1963 and I'm not sure but I believe Alice died about 1965. I remember her as an old woman, with a high pitched sing-song voice, she was a little on the heavy side and had trouble walking so she used a cane. I believe she lived alone at that time and from what I remember it was a typical "old lady" house, (not to be un-PC) with lots of antique furniture and such. Going by my Grandfather, Isaac and Alice must have been wonderful parents because Harold Carlton was the finest man I ever knew. He was smart, sweet, kind, and a-lot of fun.-- Mark Mayville
