According to the above, he died June 14, 1968 and he was 81 when he died, this would make him born in 1887. According to his Marriage Record he was married Aug 18, 1907 at the age of 19. That would place his date of birth in 1888-89. According to Jacob C. Klock delayed birth record, he was born in 1884. According to this burial record he would have been born in 1886. The 1910 Census he was 22, making him born in 1888. According to 1920 Census Records, Jacob was 34 in 1920. This would make him born in 1886. The 1930 Census said he was 41 in 1930, which would make him born in 1889.

There is a Jacob Clock found in the 1900 Census as a ward age 11, giving his birth as Jan. 1889. Parents: Unknown. If this Jacob is my grandfather, he would have been born in Jan. of 1889. Making him 18-19 when married.

He may have been born in Sanilac County and not Tuscola County. He told me his birth records were destroyed in a Court House Fire. There was a fire in Sanilac County, Michigan. There was also a Court House fire Tuscola County. There are no records of his birth in Tuscola County or Sanilac County.

In order to draw Soc. Sec. he got a delayed birth record. He just wanted to draw his Social Security early. The death record is information given by the family, from what information they had, so I do not believe it is correct. If he was born in 1886 he was only 17 when he was married and not 19 as he claimed. So I am going to use July 14, 1887 for his date of birth. But I think he was really born in Jan. of 1889.

I am not convinced that his father was Ira Klock. But, Grampa did put on his birth record that his father was Ira. Jacob used to hang around his Uncle Grantison Klock who lived in Cadillac, Michigan. So I will go with Ira Klock, being the father of Jacob until I can find proff that he was not.

She typified the "new woman" in an economic climate hostile to single parents. She broke the sex barrier as a professional person (in real estate) and in politics. In her later years, she was Butte County's "Mrs. Republican," correspondent fo governors and presidents.

The book tells of her life and includes several family pictures, including that of her grandfather, James G. Klock and her grandmother Sally Ann Mason Klock. Elsie had little to do with her father, Joel Bennett and in fact had a strong dislike for him. She rarely saw him. Elsie married Ike Hamburger, sixteen years her senior. The romance was keep a secret until their marriage was announced in the newspapers all over Montana. After they were married they left Helena, Montana for Washington, D.C. where Isaac served as a private secretary to the Republican Senator from Montana, Thomas H. Carter.

The Death of Isaac Hamburger: From the Book Elsie Hamburger "I Never Look Back"

"On October 18, 1923, shortly before the evening dinner hour, a Seattle patrolman fired a fusilade of shots at a suspected shoplifter fleeing through dense crowds on Westlake Avenue, Seattle. Patrolman S.H. Short's bullets, fired at the sidewalk to frighten the fleeing suspect into submission, ricocheted into two passersby. One was Mrs.

Violet Davis, two small children at her side. Her spinal cord was severed. The other chance target was Isaac Hamburger, shot through the abdomen. Judge E.E. Cushman, for whom Hamburger was secretary, narrowly escaped injury.

It was Friday morning, the 19th, before the telegram with news of Ike's injury, reached Elsie. She got word to Lewis to come home and made arrangements for the children to be cared for by Paradise neighbors. She was on the first available train out of Chico for Seattle on Saturday, and once on the train had more time than she would have chosen to think over both the situation ahead and the children left behind. In Portland she scribbled a hasty note to little Helen, who more than the others, Elsie feared, would be at a loss to understand the course of events. She sent back with the letter the telegram that had come to her, so that Lewis could read it to Helen and explain. But in the confusion, the letter did not get mailed.

It was in the early morning hours on Monday that the train pulled into the Seattle station and Elsie was whisked away to the hospital. Ike was conscious; he had, indeed, forced himself to remain clear, and when Elsie walked into his hospital room his face lighted with joy at seeing her. Then that well of energy he had tapped to live for a sight of her face, and word that his family was in good hands was exhausted, and Ike died holding Elsie's hand. It was 7:45 a.m., October 21."
