STEPHEN G. MOOT

Stephen G. Moot a prominent and wealthy farmer of the town of Lincoln died about 4 o'clock Monday morning at Binghamton State Hospital where he had been for several months for treatment.

The news of his death came as a shock to many of his friends who did not know that his general health had been gradually failing since he had been at the hospital.

Stephen Garner Moot was a son of Conrad G. Moot and Mary A. Chapman Moot who were among the pioneer families of this section of Madison county. His maternal grandfather was the late Col. Stephen Capman, through whose influence a post office was established at Clockville in 1816 and who was the first postmaster at that place. Mr. Moot was born on the farm upon which he resided all his life, Sept. 6, 1837. He succeeded his father as owner of that farm and another valuable farm adjoining, and occupied an elegant house known as Oak Hill Grange.

In 1863, Mr. Moot was united in marriage to Katherine Clock who died two years ago last August. Since her death his health had gradually failed until late last fall his condition became so serious that he was taken to the Binghamton hospital for treatment.

Mr. Moot was a man of wide acquaintance and many friends. While all of his life had passed at his farm home, he was interested in various enterprises and was a stockholder and director of the First National Bank of Canastota since its organization, 1890. He also served as vice-president of the board of directors until incapacitated by illness. His only surviving relative is one daughter Miss Kathleen Moot.

Mr. Moot's remains were brought to Canastota Monday evening and taken to his home at Oak Hill, where funeral services were held Thursday afternoon at 2 o'clock. The Rev. A. J. Abeel of Syracuse officiated and burial was made in Mt. Pleasant Cemetery by the side of his wife.

KATHLEEN MOOT DIES IN SYRACUSE HOSPITAL

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Mrs. Kathleen W. Moot formerly well known in Canastota died at the Crouse Irving hospital in Syracuse Wednesday. She had been there only about three hours, having been taken from Hotel Howard where she had been living for some time.

Miss Moot was born in Clockville about 45 years ago, the daughter of Stephen and Kate Clock Moot. She was educated in the public schools of Oneida graduating from the high school there about 27 years ago. She then went to the Emerson School of Oratory at Eaton where she was graduated, after which she went on the stage under the name of Muriel Brandt. The stage did not prove a success and she returned to her home at Clockville. After the death of her parents she lived on the farm for a while trying to work it with overseers but a few years ago she left for Syracuse where she has since been. Unfortunate investments or expenses made inroads on the estate from \$50,000 to \$100,000 left by her father. Some Syracuse papers stated that she died of starvation but old friends here do not think that this is true as she still must have some claim on the once famous farm of Clockville.

Her mother was a sister of Duane Clock and the funeral will be held from his home in Clockville Friday afternoon at 2 o'clock. Burial will

be in the Moot family plot at Mount Pleasant cemetery.

Other relatives in this vicinity are LeGrand Colton and Mrs. Lee Phillips. Friends of the deceased here say that for several years Miss Moot has not been well and that her mind has probably been affected by her illness.

Some time ago after the death of Samuel Smith she claimed a widow's right to his property saying that they had been married in Boston years ago but nothing was proved and it was thought that the story and claim were just a

Railroad Man Fatally Hurt In Yard Here  
Bert Klock, Conductor for D., L. & W., Slips From Car  
Train Halts Too Late  
Arm Cut Off, Skull Fractured, Dies Before Ambulance Comes

Slipping off the ladder of a Freight care while supervising switching operations near West Fayette and Wyoming Streets early this morning, Bert Klock, 66, employe of the D.,L., & W. Railroad for a quarter of a century, was injured fatally when he fell between two of the cars.

One of his arms was amputated by the wheels of ther freight car, and although police and an ambulance from St. Joseph Hospital were summoned immediately, Klock died from loss of blood and a fractured skull before he could be taken to the hospital.

Klock, a freight conductor, who lived at 509 Seymour Street, was on his way to the Great Northern warehouse, 348 West Fayette Street, with Amos Wade, engineer, to switch three cars.

The conductor had climbed a ladder on the side of one of the cars, according to police, as the train got in motion. Suddenly the conductor disappeared from sight, and Wade not seeing his lantern, brought the locomotive to a halt, but not before the wheels of the train had run over Klock.

The engineer summoned aid, but Klock was dead when the ambulance arrived and he was taken to the county morgue. The conductor was a native of Brewerton. He is survived by his wife, and a brother, Schiller Klock. Funeral arrangements are incomplete.
