Descendants of Honjost Klock

Generation No. 1

1. HONJOST² KLOCK (*HENDRICK*¹) was born Abt. 1736 in Mohawk Valley, and died 1813. He married CATHARINE KRAUSS (CROUSE) February 11, 1766 in Stone Arabia, NY. She was born March 28, 1744 in Minden, Albany Co. NY.

Notes for HONJOST KLOCK:

Also known as John Joseph, Johanna Jost Klock. He married Catharine Krauss (Crouse 2-11-1766 Church Record) He was a soldier in the Revolution. Went to Madison Co., New York and owned property in Sullivan, three miles from Clocksville, N.Y.

From the SOK Genealogy, Page 388

We are of the opinion that the Joseph (Jost) Klock herein mentioned is Jost (Joseph) Klock, (NO 1544), but to name his father and place him where he belongs is another matter. Honjost Klock, named in the will of Hendrick Klock the pioneer, was called a minor when that instrument was written in 1743, and so was born no earlier than 1722. In the Stone Arabia Church records we find the marriage of one Johan Jost Klock and Catherine Krauss (Crouse), which took place February 11, 1766. This would appear to be a rather late date for him to marry a first wife, and so if we choose to believe he was the original Honjost we must conclude he was married previous to this. The first child born to Johan Jost, and Catherine, was Anna, born Jan 2, 1767. That is the first record to appear in any church record that we have examined, concerning any Jost or Joseph Klock, and so it would seem that he was the original Honjost. However it is possible that he reached his majority in the year 1744, and marrying at that time, had a son Jost who married Catherine Crouse in 1766.

In the Sand Hill Church records is the death record of a Joseph Klock who died February 26, 1812, aged 72 years and 14 days, which makes his birth occurring on the 12th of February 1740. Who was this Joseph? ; We believe he was the Johan Jost who married Catherine Crouse, and whose will was 'Probated May 11, 1813, in which were named sons Jacob Jost, Adam, Joseph, and Frederick, and sons-in-law, George Bauder, Jacob van Loon, (or van Lone) Frederick R. Bellinger, Loadwick Bauder, and John H. Fallins. The birth record of two of the above sons, Joseph and Frederick, are found in the Stone Arabia Church records, also that of Anna who seems to have been the first-born child. We submit here an abstract from a letter written by Levi F. Bauder, son of Levi Bauder, and grandson of Joseph and Catherine Klock (No d-4) Bauder, in which he states;

"My grandmother Catherine Klock Bauder, died in Cleveland (Ohio) in the home of my parents (Levi and Eliza Prior (Phillips)(Bauder) in 1853, aged 80 years, and is buried in the Erie St. Cemetery (now E.9th at) in Cleveland Ohio. She told me when I was a boy, that she with other children, and their mothers, took refuge from

the British and Indians, in Fort Plain, N.Y, and from there saw the burning of a neighboring church. (Probably the Sand Rill Church to the west of Fort Plain) She also stated that her father and grandfather, and the father and grandfather of her husband, Loadwick Bauder, all bore arms in the Revolution."

A manuscript in the possession of Edison B. Bauder, attorney at law, of Cleavland, Ohio, written about 1887 by Ezra Bauder ,born about 1825, the son of Joseph and ___Eigenbradt, Bauder, Joseph being then eldest Son of Loadwick and Catherine Klock Bauder, in which Ezra states that he personally knew Loadwick and Catherine, and Loadwick's brother (the uncle of Ezra) George Bauder, and that Loadwick and George married Klock sisters. Note-- If Ezra stated that George Bauder, who is said to have married, Margaret Klock, was his uncle, he probably meant his great-uncle, for his own uncle George Bauder, married Gertrude Dockstader.

The above seems to clearly establish the father of Catherine Klock (No 4-d) as Joseph, and her mother as Catherine Crouse. The line of Loadwick Bauder and Catherine Klock will be found in the line of Melchoir Bauder, which precedes this page, and the line of Johan Jost Klock and Catherine Crouse, (with reference to Joseph Klock (No 1544) will be started below.

George and Ludwig Bauder were brothers. George Bauder, son of Melgert Bauder and Elizabeth Cook is said to have resided at Palatine bridge and carried on a grocery business there. As was stated there, George married Margaret Klock. Who the parents of Margaret were we do not know, but we venture an opinion that she was the daughter of Johannes Klock and wife Anna Margaret Shumacker. In the Stone Arabia Lutheran Church cemetery we have read the inscriptions, now barely legible, on the tombstones of George Bauder and his wife Margaret Klock, which no doubt are the same as noted above. We will give here the inscriptions as we read them. "George Bauder, died Jan 21., 1858, aged 85 years." "Margaret Klock, wife of George Bauder, died May 15, 1858, aged 82 years." The birth date of Margaret (1776) does not conflict with the birth dates of those children listed under the name of Johannes, and there no doubt were more children than so listed. George Bauder and Margaret Klock had no children.----SOK Genalogy "Unclassified"

Maria." And in the same records we note the following. "Catherine born Aug. 1, 1790, child of Jacob G. Klock and Maria." (The Maria in these records is the 2nd wife of Jacob G., namely; Martjie Beekman.) It will be noted that but 6 months elapse between the birth of David and Catherine. Either the officiating dominie made an error in recording the date of birth of one or the other of these children, or there was another Jacob G. Klock of whom we know nothing about; atten-is called to the sketch of Magdalena Klock for further information concerning David. David and Catherine lived near Fluvanna, Chautauous county, NY where both are buried in the cemetery at Fluvannah.

Mrs. Catharine Klock, the aged mother of Mrs. A. A. Arnold, of Concord, died this morning, aged 99 years, 7 months and 28 days. Her father was in the War of 1812, stationed at Sacketts Harbor, N. Y. Many years ago Mr. and Mrs. Klock, moved to Ellery, Chautauqua County, where they raised a large family. Mr. Klock died in Ellery some 20 years ago.

Mrs. Klock has made her home with her daughter where she died, the past five years. She will be buried at Fluvanna, N. Y. by the side of her husband and children.

40. JOHN⁵ LASHER (*MAGDALENA⁴ KLOCK, FREDRICK³, HONJOST², HENDRICK¹*) was born August 24, 1842 in St. Johnsville, New York. He married MARY E. STERLING October 09, 1870. She was born in Sammonsville, New York.

John Lasher was in the Civil War. Volunteered for service on 26 Aug. 1862. He was in Co. A 115 Regiment New York. He served in several other regiments in the Civil War and was at Harper's Ferry, West Va. where his company the 8th corps, was captured Sept. 15, 1862 and sent to a Parole Camp. Later exchanged and the company returned to Washington DC.

John, at one time served with Capt. C.N. Ballou, who would later marry John's sister Anna Margaret Lasher.

John was shot in the left ankle at Olustee, Fla., on Feb. 20, 1864. He was captured the same day and the colored troops that were with him who were left to die on the battle field. He was taken to Tallahassee, Florida. He was

held prisoner two weeks and then send to Andersonville Prison for eight and a half weeks. John got little or no medical treatment for his wound. His ankle became so infected that he had to remove the bullet. On Nov. 19, 1864 he was exchanged and sent to Maryland, then he went to Annapolis Hospital for a short stay and then to Chestnut Hill Hospital, Phila, Pa., where he stayed until furloughed home the 15th. of June, 1865.

Later he had the bullet he removed from his ankle mounted in gold and carried it as a pocket watch until his death. He passed the watch on to his grandson, Clifford Pickard.

After returning home after the Civil War he joined a group from Fort Plain and Nelliston to search for gold. They had some success in the lower Rockies but not enough to start a mining operation.

John with his father, George Lasher and his brother, Dewitt Lasher built a homes on the west side of North Main Street in Nelliston, New York. In 1871 John built a three story brick home with a ball room on the first floor. The home ended up in foreclosure and in 1889 burned. In 1905 John built a market and house on the east side Stone Arabia Street. There he operated a meat market for many years. His daughter, Maude Lasher lived in a house in back of the store. His wife Mary lived in a house with his other daughter, Ada Lasher Temple until her death at the age of Ninety years. She died in 1941 and is buried on the Lord lot in Fort Plain Cemetary, next to her mother, Adah Nancy Bell Sterling.

John died on 24 Jan. 1915 and is burried in the Fort Plain Cemetary on the Pickard lot.

John Lasher

John Lasher, (Magdalena Klock, Fredrick Klock, Honjost Klock, Hendrick Klock) was born in St. Johnsville, New York on August 24, 1842. John was the son of George Lasher and Magdalena Klock. Fredrick Klock married Magdalena Lara Klock, his second cousin, so John had two connections back to Hendrick Klock.

John Lasher served in the Civil War. He volunteered on August 26, 1862 with Co. A , 115th Regiment of the New York Volunteer Infantry. For volunteering his family received \$25.00 from the town of St. Johnsville and \$48.00 from the County of Montgomery. The 115th moved on August 30, 1862 to Sandy Hook, Md. John was assigned to the 8th Corps at Harper's Farry, West Virginia where his unit was captured by Col. Niles and on September 15, 1862. His unit was sent to a Parole Camp until exchanged in November 1862 and sent to Washington DC. John served in several units during the Civil War, taking part in several battles. On some point the served with Capt. C.N. Ballon who would later marry John's sister, Anna Margaret Lasher.

At a battle at Olustee, Florida on Feburary 20, 1864, John was shot in the left ankle and captured by the Southern Forces. Several colored troops that fell in battle at Olustee were shot or left to die in the field while John was taken prisoner. He was taken to Tallahassee, Florida for a couple weeks and then sent to Andersonville prison. He was there for about eight weeks, receiving no medical attention for the injured ankle it became infected and John had to remove the bullet. On Nov. 19, 1864 John was exchanged and taken to Annapolis Maryland Hospital for a couple weeks and then furloughed to Chestnut Hill Hospital until he was discharged the 15th of June in 1865 because of his wound. John kept the bullet he took from his ankle and had it mounted in gold and put on a pocket watch which he carried until he died. He passed this watch on to his grandson, Clifford Pickard.

After the Civil War, he joined a group from Fort Plain and Nellison to search for gold in the lower Rockies. He had some success but not enough to open a mine. John returned to Nellison, New York and married Mary E. Sterling on October 9, 1870. John's father, George Lasher and his brother, Dewitt Lasher built homes on the west side of North Main Street in Nellison. In 1871 John built a three story brick home which included a large ball room. This venture ended up in foreclosure and in 1889 the building burned. In 1905, John built a home with a meat market in front which he operated for several years. John and Mary had two children (that I know of) Maud and Ada Lasher. John died on Jan 24, 1915 and is burried in the Fort Plain Cemetery, on Pickard Lot. Mary Lasher died at 90 years of age in 1941. She is burried on the Lord lot in Fort Plain next to her mother, Adah Nancy Bell Sterling.
