He died during the Civil war and Mrs. Snell later married Barnet Hax. One child was born of her first marriage, a son, Lorenzo. Francina and Barnet Hax are buried in Town of Orleans, Fort Corners Cemetery, Jefferson County, New York.

The 1900 U.S. Census for Raisinville, Monroe, Michigan has an Adam Klock (75) that was also born in March 1825 in New York with wife Lucy A. 70, born March 1830 in New York, married for 51 years. Mr. Jeremiah Klock, aged 86 years, died Sunday morning at 8;30 O'clock at his home on Nichols street, after a short illness, due to the infirmities of age. He had been in failing health for several years. Mr. Klock was a son of Adam and Nancy Hart Klock being one of a family of ten children, and he was born in Herkimer county, N.Y. on May 3, 1824. His parents were of German descent and when the subject of this sketch came with his parents to

Charleston township, when he was twelve years of age. He could not speak a word of English.
