"Dr. Woodward Warren - Aged and Esteemed Citizen Died Last Night. A man once prominent in the practice of the medical profession in this vicinity, and who during a long life had held the highest respect of all who knew him, passed away in the person of Dr. Woodward Warren, who died at the residence of his daughter, Mrs. E.B. Guile (of 2 Taylor Avenue) at 11 o'clock last night. He removed from Boonville to Utica seven years ago and since that time had continued to reside in this city. Dr. Warren was born in Deerfield September 5, 1823. He was the son of Woodward and Mary Seaman Warren and came of good New England stock. He secured employment on the Utica Observer, but when about 30 years of age gave up his position to commence the study of medicine in the office of Dr. Watson. Studying medicine at the same time was Dr. C. Judson Hill, who later was favored with an extensive business also. On being admitted to practice, Dr. Warren took up his residence in Deerfield and after living there about six years, removed to Boonville, where with the exception of two years spent in Madison, he had continued to reside. He was recognized as a most skilled physician and esteemed as a man of the highest character, and he enjoyed a very large practice. Seven years ago, he retired and had since made his home with his daughter in this city.

Dr. Warren, in addition to his ability in the medical profession, had a liking for the line of literary endeavor and evidenced much talent for writing. Years ago he wrote poems that were widely read and well received and even of late had written some excellent poetry and prose sketches. He was a member of the Methodist Church. He was enrolled also in the Oneida County Homeopathic Medical Society and took much interest in its affairs. Dr. Warren's first wife was Nancy Biddlecome who died in 1864. About 36 years ago, he married Fanny M. Clark" (Note: should be Klock) "who survives, as do the following children: Mrs. A. M. Whiffen of Oswego, Mrs. A.N. Irving Klock, for many years a respected and well-to-do farmer of the town of Lenox, died suddenly at the Brunswick hotel, Syracuse, last Friday evening. He had been ill three or four days. I believe that I have the information you need to fill the voids. Ann Eliza Klock was called Ida by her parents, James G and Sallie Klock. Ida was born in 1850 and married my great-grandfather Joel Rice Bennett on Dec.1,1875. Joel R. Bennett was born Jan 1, 1854 in Waterloo Iowa. Theirs was obviously a rocky marriage from the beginning with disapproval from her parents. He left shortly after their first child, Elsie Bennett(Hamburger) was born Dec. 12,1876. He reconciled long enough to produce their second daughter Gertrude b. April of 1879. Soon after, a divorce was obtained for Ida by her parents. Why the marriage did not succeed is mere speculation on my part but it may

have been due to his philandering and mental cruelty. I do know a lot about his ancestry which is quite extensive. Both of his parents had Native American ancestry along with a pedigree going back to the 1st century C.E. in Europe. Joel R. Bennett's second wife died under mysterious circumstances and his third wife was my great grandmother Josephine Bequette who was nearly full-blooded Illiniwek (Native Am.) Their oldest daughter Hazel was my grandmother. But back to the Klock family, yes, Ida Klock married James Merrill and had a son James Merrill. Ida Klock(Bennett)Merrill is buried at the cemetery in Chico Ca., along with her James Merrill and her daughter Elsie Bennett Hamburger. I have been there and photographed the graves. Elsie Bennett Hamburger had four children by Isaac Hamburger, Lewis(1906-2003), Nancy(1908-1986), Elsie Mae(1911-2003), and Helen(1915-1994). Lewis and Nancy had no children. Gertrude Bennett married Charles Sowder in 1902 and they had two children, Rev. Charles Sowder and James. I have photo of James and his wife Marie. They lived in Santa Cruz Ca. I mentioned the book by Elsie Hamburger, "I Never Look Back", which was written by Lois Halliday McDonald, whom I've met and talked family with just 2 years back. There is extensive information in that book about this side of the Klock family that you would find very interesting. I bought the book on line for a couple of bucks..I highly suggest you try and get it as it contains a wealth of info on the Klock family. The book contains many photographs.
