" Funeral services were held yesterday for Mrs Cora Bailey, 77 years old, who died Sunday morning at the home of her daughter, Mrs Neil Booker near Dover. The Rev. Richard A. Hayes, Pastor of St Mathews Episcopal Church, conducted the service, and interment was in the Chatfield cemetery. Mrs Bailey had been in failing health for some months.
