The 1870 Fillmore County, Minnesota census records film number 0830423 page #207 lists William David as a farmer born in NY. It also lists his wife as Amelia, 34, and five children. The census lists William as being 46. That would make him born about 1824 which would make him 12 years old when his first son was born. The Obit, says he was born Aug. 9, 1817.

DEATH:

Obituary notices from Chatfield, Fillmore/Olmsted county, Minn.

"William A. David Esq., aged 61 years."

"The deceased had been a resident of this vicinity for twelve years or more and was looked up on as an industrious, quiet citizen. He leaves a wife and several sons and daughters to mourn his loss, with whom we deeply sympathize."

WILL:

A copy of the will of William A. David is in the possession of Darrel J. Ayler and read as:

"To all whom it may concern: I William A. David of the town of Jordan of the county of Fillmore and state of Minnesota, being of sound mind and memory do make, publish and declare this my last Will and Testament. First I give Wm J. David, Emma J. Klock, Charles A. David, George A. David, Margaret L. Johnson and Carrie M. Gile fifty cents each they being my children by Sovina David, my first wife. Second, I give grand convey and bequeath for the use of my present family consisting in all eight in no.(number). My wife Amelia David and seven children named as follows. Maryett David, Willis A. David, Hiram David, Marven and Melvin David, Cora S. David and John H. David all the rest of my estate both real and personal of every name and value to have and hold the same unto their sole use and benefit forever there shall be no division made between the last eight until such time as there shall be no minor children then if any remain it shall be divided equal. Third I nominate and appoint Amelia David of the Town of Jordan, County of Fillmore and state of Minnesota Executorix (sic) of this my last Will and Testament. Fourth I duly direct that Amelia David executorix of this my last Will and Testament make suitable provisions from this estate for the education and support for the last seven children above named and that my said administrator have the care and custody of said children during their minority in witness whereof, I have set my hand and seal this 28th day of December A. D. 1876." This will was probated in the Village of Preston, county of Fillmore on the 4th day of June AD 1877.

Information received from David Elton indicates that William was married twice and had a total of eighteen children from these marriages. It is said that his first wife went insane. She believed that she had demons in her chest, which drove her out of her mind. William David gave her a case knife as she wanted to cut it out. (That pacified her). It is believed that she is buried in Waukesha.

William then met the Klock family and later married Amelia.

He was a cobbler by trade. He also raised broom corn and cared for it. In the winter, he made his brooms and sold them for .25 cents each. He would travel from town to town. Then W . A. David left Wisconsin for Chatfield, Minnesota when Ed was 6 months old, which would have been about April 1865. Their reason for moving to Chatfield was that Jim their second born was a good business man, a blacksmith and wagon maker by trade. He made it look rosy to his father, William, who decided to move to Chatfield. He wrote to his wife and told her to sell what she had and come to Chatfield.

New York, and died March 11, 1905 in Hillyard, Spokane, Washington. He married EMMA JEAN DAVID October 04, 1857 in Waukesha, Wisconsin, daughter of WILLIAM DAVID and SOVIAN HALL. She was born 1839 in New York, and died March 16, 1910 in Hillyard, Spokane, Washington.

Notes for GEORGE WARDEN KLOCK:

George Warden Klock was born September 21, 1839 in Fort Plain, New York. He was the son of Archibald Klock and Hannah Moore. He married Emma Jane David on October 4, 1857 in Waukesha, Wisconsin. George Warden Klock was 5'6" ½ inches tall and had dark a completion and had dark eyes and bleached hair. George was a carpenter by trade. George enlisted to fight in the Civil War in April of 1861 with Company F of the 5th Wisconsin Infantry. Luck was not with George and he was stricken with measles on his first day out in the field. He was transported on an open wagon and in the rain to and ended up in the hospital. He later returned to his regiment but was unable to return to duty. George was discharged, sent home to die on December 9, 1861. With the love and care of his wife and family, and change of climate, he recovered from his disease. From December 1861 to February 1864, George stayed home to fight his illness. George was a patriot and on February 17, 1864 he reenlisted in the 2nd. Battery from Wisconsin where he served until the end of the war. George had a cough that stayed with him the rest of his life. George and his family moved to Washington State in 1902 in hopes that the climate would help his condition. George died March 13, 1905 in Spokane, Washington and is buried in Fairmont Cemetery in Spokane.

George and Emma Jane had four children, Isabelle, Ida, Carrie and Katlee.
