"Dr. Woodward Warren - Aged and Esteemed Citizen Died Last Night. A man once prominent in the practice of the medical profession in this vicinity, and who during a long life had held the highest respect of all who knew him, passed away in the person of Dr. Woodward Warren, who died at the residence of his daughter, Mrs. E.B. Guile (of 2 Taylor Avenue) at 11 o'clock last night. He removed from Boonville to Utica seven years ago and since that time had continued to reside in this city. Dr. Warren was born in Deerfield September 5, 1823. He was the son of Woodward and Mary Seaman Warren and came of good New England stock. He secured employment on the Utica Observer, but when about 30 years of age gave up his position to commence the study of medicine in the office of Dr. Watson. Studying medicine at the same time was Dr. C. Judson Hill, who later was favored with an extensive business also. Death of Myron Klock--- A Respected Resident Passes Away After a Brief Illness

Myron Klock, an old and highly respected resident of Canastota, died at his home, in East Hickory street, Thursday evening, August 29, aged 67 years. He was down town Saturday evening and returned home about 9 o'clock. and shortly afterwards he was taken with severe cramps. He suffered intense pain and his condition rapidly grew more serious. Death was caused by congestion of the brain.

Mr. Klock was the son of Solmon and Nancy Ann Klock, and was born in St. Johnsville. He moved to the town

Irving Klock, for many years a respected and well-to-do farmer of the town of Lenox, died suddenly at the Brunswick hotel, Syracuse, last Friday evening. He had been ill three or four days. His wife, who had been his constant attendant, left him at about 4 o'clock, returning in a few minutes finding him unconscious upon the floor. He died at 9 o'clock, not having returned to consciousness. Cause of death is given as cerebral apoplexy. Mr. Klock was the oldest son of Solomon Klock, of Wampsville and a half brother of Theron and Myron Klock and brother Theron and Myron Klock and brother of Mrs. G.G. Stephens of Oneida Valley.
