Dexter, Nov. 25 -- Mrs. Nett Klock Crouse, 77, widow of Ezra Crouse of the town of Lyme, died Saturday at 11 a.m. at the home of her son, Roy Crouse, in this village. She had been in failing health three years.

She was born in the town of Lyme near Three Mile Bay on September 13, 1852, a daughter of George Henry and Hannah Shuler Klock. Many years ago she married Mr. Crouse who died about twelve years ago. Practically her entire life had been spent in the town of Lyme but for the past six months she had resided here with her son.
