Obituary of Lipe Klock from Utica Paper

St. Johnsville---Funeral services will be held this afternoon for Lipe Klock, 72, at 2 p.m. at his home, Lion Avenue, the Rev. George Kling, pastor, St. Pauls Lutheran Church, officiating. Mr. Klock, ill for several years, died Friday, Oct. 30, 1936, at the Amsterdam City Hospital. Mr. Klock was born July 30, 1864, at historic Fort Klock, Revolutionary War Fortress, in the town of St. Johnsville. He was a son of the late Amos and Nancy Lipe Klock, and a direct descendant of the Klock family so prominent in the Revolution. His interest in the family led to his election a few years ago as honorary president of the family group. Leaving the farm on which he was born early in live. Mr. Klock worked for for several years as fireman on the New York Central and later, for ten years, had charge of the railroad trestle which until a few years ago was located just east of this village. After leaving the employ of the railroad, Mr. Klock returned to the farm on which old Fort Klock now serves as the residence. He operated the farm for twenty years, until he came to this village to reside a few years ago in Lion Avenue. Mr. Klock was a member of the old St. Johnsville Band, at one time one of the Mohawk Valley's formost muscial aggregations. He was a cornetist.

Resided at Fort Klock in St Johnsville. After the death of Lipe Klock Sr. Lipe Jr. and Adam where sent to live with half sisters and brothers.

Lipe Klock was bonr July 30, 1864 and died Nov. 7, 1936. He was the son of Amos and Nancy Lipe Klock and is buried in Klock Cemetery, St. Johnsville, New York.

He moved here in 1906 after his graduation from the University of Michigan Medical School and founded Daytona Beach Sanitarium. He kept the Sanitarium open until 1944 when his only son, Floyd, an Air Force flight surgeon, died in a glider crash in England.

Dr. Klock and his son had planned to operate the place together after the war's end.

Dr. Klock was born in Edwardsville, New York and attended the State Normal School. He started his career as a country school teacher. He served in World War I as an Army Captain.

He served as a member of old Daytona's Council and after consolidation as City Commissioner for two terms. As City Commissioner he fought and helped abolish a pratice of spending all the budget money before the end of the year and then borrowing money on time warrants.

He was a member of the Elks, Moose and the Assn. of Military Surgeons.

He is survived by his wife, Willie of Daytona Beach; two daughters, Mrs. Robert Bozeman Ormond Beach and Mrs. W.J. Rose, Holy Hill; 11 grandchildren and five great grandchildren.

### Guy A. Klock

Guy A. Klock, M.D. (James Orville, Luther, John J. Jr., John J., Johannes, Hendrick) was born April 5, 1876 in Edwardsville, N.Y. Guy's father, James Orville Klock was born in 1848 and spent his live as a successful farmer in Harrisville, New York. His mother was Helen (Hadlock) who was born May 3, 1843. Guy spent his youth working on his father's farm. He attended public schools and later attended the State Normal School and after graduating taught at Newton Falls, New York in 1900 to 1901. Then he entered the medical department of the University of Michigan. Guy worked as a Barber in the winter and a house painter in the summer to pay his way through Medical School. After he earned his medical degree, Dr. Klock moved to Daytona Beach Florida.

In June of 1906, Guy had to borrow money to pay for his railroad fair and he was broke when he arrived in Daytona Beach. Fortune smiled on Dr. Klock and he made 50 cents the first day he arrived in Daytona Beach... His medical practice grew and in a few years he had built one fo the best in the city.

Dr. Klock specialized in surgery and in 1907 opened the first private hospital at 42 Second Avenue in the old town of Daytona. He later purchased property at 532 South Beach Street and moved in there, enlarging his private hospital.

In 1912 he went to Europe and attended the International Meeting for Research Work at Dresden, Germany, paying special attention to the lectures on the subject of tropical diseases. Again in 1925 he went to Vienna for two months to study and expand his knowledge in surgery.

In 1917 he volunteered under the Red Cross for the United States Public Health Services and for a long time held and preformed the duties of Acting Assistant Surgeons of the U.S. Department of Public Health.

During WW-1, Dr. Klock was stationed at Panama City, Florida. He later joined a company of the Florida National Guard as a private and was promoted to First Lieutenant in 1919 and in 1920 the Adjutant General appointed him to State Surgeon of the Medical Corps of the Florida National Guard with the rank of Major. The Governor of Florida appointed him on the Board of Medical Ezaminers. He later resigned this position.

In the fall of 1920 he was one of five physicians appointed by the U.S. Government to receive post-graduate training in the Army Medical School at Washington. After completion of his work, he received his diploma on May 26, 1921.

Dr. Guy Klock took great interest in local government, serving eight years as a member of City Council and twelve years as City Health Officer of old Daytona. He was once nominated for the United States Senate for the state of Florida and received a flattering vote for the office. Dr. Klock was member of the Association of Military Surgeons. An article about Dr. Klock appears in the Who's Who and What to See in Florida and in the History of Volusia County, Florida. Dr. Klock was member of the Elks, Moose and Maccabees.

Dr. Klock, married Frances Fearon of Morrisville, New York, in 1898. Guy and Frances had three children, Maude (Mrs. William McCoy) Dorothy and Floyd. In 1923 he married Wilbe H. Tallman of Baltimore. Guy and Betty had on child, Betty Ann.

Guy's only son, James Floyd Klock was an Air Force Flight Surgeon, and while stationed in London, England during WW-11, James Floyd was killed in a glider crash. Guy and his son, Floyd had plans on running the Klock Hospital together after the war. When his son was killed, he closed the Hospital in 1944. Dr. Klock continued practicing medicine. He was one of the oldest practicing physicians in Daytona until he was 76 years of age. He died in 1953, after 47 years of practice, two months after his retirement and 10 days after his 77 birthday.

Dear Dave,

My great grandfather, Amos Klock, had two sons by his first wife and two daughters by his second. One son was my grandfather, Frederick, who was forced by Amos to marry my grandmother. He left shortly after my father was born and took the name of his mother and went by the name of Fred Weir. His mother also left Amos who remarried. His daughters were my two aunts, Mildred and Myrtle. They were my great aunts and were a great source of joy to me. The lived in Ogdensburg, New York. Mildred married and raised a family. Myrtle never married. Mildred was a talker. Myrtle wasn't. But whatever Mildred decided to do her younger sister followed. Aunt Mildred was a tireless organizer she was active in the VFW Auxilliary and the American Legion Auxilliary. She founded the St. Lawrence County Association of Senior Citizens.

In my last conversation with Aunt Mildred she was recovering from having broken her leg. She was being looked after by a convent of nuns at St. Joseph's in Ogdensburg. She was 93 and could talk any part of your body off. She got better and was discharged. Everytime I got back to the North Country I tried to visit her. But last spring. I didn't make it over to see her. She died at the age of 93 shortly before her 94th birthday in May of 2004. She was born in Edwards, New York. Her sister was her constant companion. Myrtle was born in Govuverneur, New York, my hometown, and where by great grandfather lived for over 50 years. Every organization my Aunt Nukdred was a member of, she had Aunt Myrtle as a willing participant. Aunt Myrtle was a spinster and died shortly after Aunt Mildred at the age of 91. James was a member of the 27 Infantry Regiment, which took part in the bloody invasion, and conquest of the Japanese held island of Saipan. In July of 1944, Pvt. James R. Jackson was reported missing in action in Saipan. James Jackson never had a furlough or saw any of his family since he joined the Army in 1941. On January 15, 1944, his father Andrew Jackson received a telegram from the adjutant general advising him that his son, Pvt. James R. Jackson who had been reported missing since July in Siapan, was killed.

James served proudly in the Army during WW-II and gave his life in the service of his country.

Irving Klock, for many years a respected and well-to-do farmer of the town of Lenox, died suddenly at the Brunswick hotel, Syracuse, last Friday evening. He had been ill three or four days. His wife, who had been his constant attendant, left him at about 4 o'clock, returning in a few minutes finding him unconscious upon the floor. He died at 9 o'clock, not having returned to consciousness. Cause of death is given as cerbral apoplexy. # Morgan Klock

Morgan Klock, a highly respect farmer of Watertown, New York, was born near St. Johnsville, Montgomery county, New York, April 13, 1834. His paternal grandfather, George G.I. Klock, was also a native of that county, born in 1770, and his early years wer there passed, while in the public schools of the neighborhood he acquired his education. Later he engaged in farming in the old home neighborhood for a long period, but his last years were passed in Watertown, where he died after reaching the eightieth milestone of life's journey. His wife bore the maiden name of Harriet Goodale, and they were the parents of four children, of whom but one is now living, Polly, who became the wife of Arlie Klock, and resides in St. Johnsville, New York. Mrs. Harriet Goodale Klock passed away at the age of eighty years.

Stephen Klock, son of George G.I. Klock, who was born in Montgomery county in 1802, and was there reared and educated, afterward removed to Lyme, New York, where he remained until 1859. In that year he settled on a farm of two hundred acres on Washington street, near Watertown, and continued to cultivation of his land until his death, which occurred on the 20th of May 1878, when he was sixty-five years of age. His political support was given to the Democratic party, and he was a member of the Masonic fraternity, with which his father also affiliated. He married Anna Bellinger, who was born in St. Johnsville, Montgomery county, and died there at the age of eighty years. Mrs. Klock also passed away at the age of four score years, and, like her husband, she was a member of the Presbyterian church. They were the parents of six children, of who me four are now living: Morgan; Lovian, the wife of Albert Peck, of Watertown; Milton R., of Watertown; and Sephanna, who married Joshua Flanders of Rodman, New York.

Morgan Klock spent his early years in Lyme, and when he had completed a common school course he continued to render assistance to his father in the work on the home farm until twenty-five years of age. Thereafter he engaged in the operation of the old homestead for eight years, and then came to Watertown, where he purchased his present farm, then comprising one hundred and twenty-seven acres, and ,with the exception of three years passed in the city, he has resided thereon continuously since. He also owns a farm of two hundred and ten acres in Le Ray. He has an excellent set of building upon the farm which he occupies, and fro many years he conducted business as a retail milk dealer. His agricultural interests have been capably conducted along modern business lines, and have resulted in bring to him creditable and gratifying success. He has sold most of the home place for park purposes, and now owns

one hundred acres near by, on Washington street. His political support is given to the Democracy, and he attends the First Presbyterian church.

In 1957 Mr. Klock married Catherine J. Baird, who was born in Charlstown, Montgomery county, New York, in 1838. Her father, Robert Baird, was for many years engaged in farming in Lyme, New York, and died at the home of his daughter, Mrs. Klock, when seventy-five years of age. His wife, who bore the maiden name of Eunice McDuffee, was born in 1810, and was reared in Charlestown. She died at the age of eighty years. Of her four children only one is now living; Anna E., wife of Lester C. Angell, of Three Mile Bay.

Mr. and Mrs. Klock were the parents of three children, of whom two are living. The daughter, Carrie K., is the wife of Sterling A. Sill, of Watertown, New York, and they have five children-Frederick W., Allen P., John M., Kate W., and Carrie E. Percy L., son of Morgan Klock, is a graduate of Hamilton College, and for a number of years engaged in teaching as principal in Richfield and Saratoga. He is now a practicing lawyer of New York city. He married Miss Kate Thomsom, of Oswego, New York Morgan Klock lost one son, Fred G. Klock, who died in 1897, at the age of thirty-four years. He had been liberally educated, and was general manager of the firm of Farwell & Rhines. He married Miss Grace Becker, of Pulaski, New York, who is now residing in Watertown, with her four children, George, Morgan, Eunice and Catherine.
