92. ISAAC PUTMAN⁵ KLOCK (*JOHN J. JR.*⁴, *JOHN J.*³, *JOHANNES J.*², *HENDRICK*¹) was born 1812 in Montgomery County, New York, and died June 09, 1876 in Fon Du Lac, Wi.. He married LANY ANN NELLIS. She was born February 02, 1819 in Stone Arbia, New York, and died August 15, 1900 in Montgomery County, New York.

Notes for ISAAC PUTMAN KLOCK:

Isaac Putnam Klock is reported to have had about 18 children. 15 lived to be adults and three died as infants. He may have had as many as three wives. He lived in a Sod House in Fon du Lac, Wi. in 1854 or 55 Isaac also served in the Civil War. He farmed 100 acres in Fond du Lac and owned a mill.

Found this on the 1850 United States Federal Census Record about Isaac Klock. Isaac Putman did have a Isaac and Lucinda. Now, Isaac E. Klock, Jr.'s grandmother was Nancy. (Or the first wife of John J. Klock, Jr.) I have her date of birth in 1784, close enough to be her. The Nancy listed in the census below would have been born about 1883 and died March 21, 186. Also her X-husband John J. Klock Jr., as born December 08, 1773 and died December 20, 1852. Now John J. Klock was married three times and would not be married to Nancy at this time. Now it looks like Unice was one of Isaac's wives. I don't have her listed as one of his wives, but it sure looks like it. She would probably be a second wife as there were children older than Lucinda and Isaac and she probably remarried Morris Hawkins and she kept the two small children listed below, Isaac and Lucinda. (Lany Ann Nellis would be his third wife.) He must have recovered the children and took them with him to Fond du Lac, Fond du Lac, Wisconsin as they are listed with him in 1860. I do not know who his first wife would have been.

Notes for CHRISTIAN KLOCK:

Christian joined the service in April 1861 with a friend and neighbor Colwert Pier after the attack on Fort Sumter. Christian served with Pier in Company I, 1st Wisconsin Infantry from April to August of 1861. 1st Wisconsin Volunteer Infantry Regiment, a unit that was nicknamed the Badger Boys. The following month he re-enlisted in Co. K, 1st Wisconsin Infantry and was promoted to 1st. Sergeant. The following May he was promoted to 2nd. Lt. He took part in the battles of Perryville and Stone River. In the spring of 1863, he was promoted to 1 Lt. He was in the battles of Chickamauga and Missionary Ridge. He was promoted to Captain and was in the Chattahoochee, Peach Tree Creek, Atlanta and Jonesborough before being mustered out that October.

On May 1865 he married. They did not have any children. They moved to Texas in 1874 and farmed twelve miles from Waco, Texas. In 1879 a hail storm destroyed his crops and broke 56 panes of glass from his home. He recovered from the hail storm and began raising sheep. In 1890 he moved to Monroe County, Georgia and was a landlord, renting land to black tenant farmers.

Jacob may have went by the C-spelling

Hudson Corners Cemetery Records, Allegan Township, Allegan County, Michigan has Jacob last name spelled "Clock". He changed the spelling of his name to a "C". Also buried in Hudson Corners Cemetery is his wife, Elvira Wilson Klock. Also a daughter, Baby, dau of J.W. & Sarah age 23days. This was the daughter of James W. Klock and Sarah A. Brown. James was the son of Jacob and Elvira Wilson Klock. Also note SOK Genealogy has date of birth of Jacob as February 11, 1814, SOK and cemetery records give date of birth as Feb. 14, 1814 and date of death as Dec. 25, 1893.
