The Lonyo family traces its roots back to Pierre Denis Alognon, who immigrated in 1647 to Quebec from the province of Perche in France. Three generations later, sometime in the 1700s, Louis Loignon emigrated from Quebec to Detroit, which was then a small settlement on the Detroit River.

Here, Louis Lognon (as the name came to be spelled) established the first bakery in the settlement at the present site of the First National Bank building. Bakers were key people in the community at that time. Most homes featured large central fireplaces, used for both heating and cooking; baking in them was difficult.

Sometime before the turn of the century, the minutes of the Corporation of the Town of Detroit recorded that the board of trustees appointed Mr. Lognon to the position of fire inspector.

At that time, fire was an ever-present threat. Besides the danger posed by fireplaces, all homes were made of wood, crowded together inside Detroit's wooden stockade fence. Each home and business was required to have on hand, at all times, a barrel filled with water, two three-gallon buckets and a ladder able to reach the roof. The fire inspector regularly made his rounds and reported any deficiencies to the board. Fines were levied on those homeowners not in compliance.

These precautions did not stop gale-force winds from spreading a small stable fire throughout the town on June 11, 1805. The entire settlement of Detroit was destroyed. This unfortunate event was so important in the history of the area that, to this day, the Latin phrase "Speramus Meliora: Resurget Cineribus" appears on the official seal of the city of Detroit ("We hope for better days: it shall arise from its ashes.")

Mr. Lognon owned a "strip" farm adjacent to land owned by Gov. Lewis Cass. Lognon's oldest son, Louis II, often told family and friends that his birth had been at the family farm near what is now the northwest corner of Jefferson and Woodward avenues. Because roads were few and generally in poor condition at the time, farms typically were on long, narrow parcels of land running inland from the Detroit River because travel by water was easier. The Lognon farm ran from the river back to where Tiger Stadium is located.

When Mr. Lognon died, the farm was divided among his heirs. His son, Louis, exchanged his share of the property for a farm in what was then Springwells Township, near Dearborn. That farm became well known in the area and the road along its west side was named Lonyo Road.

As more and more people with English backgrounds moved into southeast Michigan, difficulties arose with the pronunciation of the family name. To overcome this problem, the spelling was changed from Lognon to the phonetic spelling, Lonyo.

In the mid-1800s, Louis Lonyo II's farm was found to contain what the family called "blue clay," earth suitable for making red bricks strong enough to use in commercial construction. Gradually the focus of activities on the farm changed from farming to brick making.

In 1876, Louis Lonyo II and his oldest son, Andrew, formed a partnership that, in time, became the Lonyo Brick Company. The business flourished, at its peak including three brickyards. Andrew (whose picture appears on the front of this brochure) was in the brick business for 38 years, retiring in 1912. Andrew's two younger brothers, Albert and Louis Lonyo III, also moved from farming into brick making, forming the Lonyo Brothers Brick Company. Together the two companies represented an important segment of the brick industry, making the family very prosperous.

After Andrew Lonyo's retirement, his sons Orville, Andrew W. and Arnold Lonyo joined with their brother-in-law, John W. Harsha, to form the Lonyo_Harsha Brick Company. This firm operated for years, closing when the supply of "blue clay" ran out.

Today, Lonyo bricks are being reclaimed from buildings being demolished in Detroit and reused in new homes and commercial buildings being constructed throughout the area. Builders and architects prize the weathered look of these historic bricks.

Andrew Lonyo III, who created the Lonyo Family Endowment Fund in 1998, was for many years a professor in the business division at Macomb Community College and an amateur genealogist. Affection for the family members he knew in his youth, and pride in his family's long history in metro Detroit, motivated Andrew Lonyo III to establish the Lonyo Family Endowment Fund with the Community Foundation for Southeastern Michigan so that residents of southeast Michigan would benefit from his family's heritage for generations to come.
