Man Found Dead in Field

Napoli-- July 10, Hiram Klock of this place was found dead with a broken neck hanging from the handles of his plow in a field which he had been plowing Monday afternoon. Mrs. Klock had gone out to call her husband to dinner and found him dead. The horses hitched to the plow were standing quietly. Coroner Dr. Bourne of Salamanca gave a certificate of accidental death. No theory as to the cause of Mr. Klock's death has been formed. He had been dead about an hour when found.

The deceased was 60 years old and is survived by his wife, Ellen; two brothers, Fred Klock of Randolph and George Klock of Tilcounty; (?) four sisters. Mrs. May Wallace and Mrs. George Jones of Randolph, Mrs. Henry Hall of Jamestown, and Mrs. Hugh Crawford.

The funeral was held from the family home this afternoon.

Ellen, according to census records name was Ada or Ida. No record of any children born to them.

" MRS. SCOTT DEAD OF HEART AILMENT "

The death of Mrs. Elizabeth Klock Scott, 69, widow of William G. Scott, occurred early last Thursday at the home of Miss. Irene Hungerford in Mexico. ( New York ) Mrs. Scott was born in Wswego in 1867, a daughter of Simeon Klock and Elizabeth Jones Klock. Much of her childhood and early years of maturity were spend in this village, it was here she married Mr. Scott, then deputy sheriff. After the expiration of Mr. Scott's term, as deputy sheriff, the family moved to Pittsbure, Penn., several years later returning to Pulaski where Mr Scott died March 1927. Mrs. Scott was a member of Pulaski Congregational Church, Ontario Chapter, Daughters of the American Revolution and Oswego chapter Order of the Eastern Star.

Surviving are two sons, Harold K. Scott of Kenmore, NY and John Albert Scott of Rochester, two grandchildren, one sister, Miss. Adeline Klock of Oswego, and several nephews and nieces. The body was brought to the home of her nephew, Frederick A. Clark, Lake Street, by Albert E. Lawrence, local undertaker, where the funeral was held Saturday. Rev. Alfred W. He had for many years been a traveling salesman and about 10 years ago he retired. Mr. Scott was a member of Aeonian Lodge, F. & A.M., of Oswego. He is survived by his widow, Mrs. Elizabeth K. Scott, and two sons. Harold K. Scott and John A. Scott, all of Syracuse. Rev. Lowell H. Palmer, pastor of First Congregational church of Pulaski, will conduct last rites at the funeral home of Albert K. Lawrence at 3:30 o'clock, Wednesday afternoon. Burial will be in Pulaski cemetery.

The death of William Gray Scott of Syracuse, occurred Sunday morning, following a long illness. Mr. Scott was born in Pulaski, November 25th., 1866. He was son of John Albert and Martha Gray Scott and the grandson of William H. Gray, a resident of Pulaski, where he was owner of the leading hotel.

On June 26, 1893, he was united in marriage with Miss Elizabeth Klock. He was deputy sheriff and keeper of Pulaski jail in the early nineties. He was a traveling salesman for Wilcox Brothers, of Oswego, many years and made extensive acquaintances in this part of the state. He went to Chicago, from Pittsburg, ten years ago, and there his health failed; since then he has been unable to engage in any business for more than a brief period. He is survived by his wife, two sons, Harold K and John A. Scott, and a granddaughter, Betty Scott. Funeral services will be held at the undertaking rooms of Mr. A. E. Lawrence, today at 3:30.

CD. Klost, superintendent of the parks of Cleveland, dates his service with Cleveland parks at 1883, when he was placed in charge of Wade Park. This beautiful spot is the result of ten and a half years of unremitting care and painstaking arrangement and landscape gardening of Mr. Klost, and his promotion to general superintendent is a merited recognition of his ability to fill a more responsible position.

Mr. Klost was born in Chemung county, New York, October 17, 1854. His father, Sanford Klost, a native of Herkimer county, York State, was born near Little Falls in 1809. He became a civil engineer and spent his life in land surveying and construction work, on the Erie Railroad. HE died in 1891. His antecedents are believed to have been from Holland. Our subject's mother's maiden name was Millie Petrie. Seven children resulted from this marriage: George, deceased; Monroe, deceased; Peter, at Elmira, New York; Jarvis, at Antigo, Wisconsin; Ester, the wife of William Decker; Fannie, who married Jacob Sheppie. And C.D. At Sixteen Mr. Klost left the common schools and took up the burdens of life independently. He came west and made Cuyahoga county his stopping place, working on the farm of L.R. Streeter. From this place he came to Cleveland, as superintendent of Wade Park, as before stated.

Mr. Klost was married September 16, 1876, to Aggie Haycox, whose father, John Haycox reared eight children. They came originally from Husk, England. Mr. Klost's children are: Ebba, sixteen years; Monroe, eleven; and Jarvis, seven.

Alphonso Klock shot and killed Moses C. Holden. Alphonso had a sister who was retarded. Holder was warned to stay away from her. He already was the father of one illegitimate child. After repeated warning to stay away, he was caught in the barn with her. Alphonso shot and killed him. Below is one article that was in the N.Y. Times on August 13, 1880.

Utica, Aug. 12--Alphonso Klock, 19 years old, who admitted the killing of Moses C. Holden, of Herkimer, near Little Falls, on Sunday last, at midnight, had been held by the Coroner for murder in the first degree. Holden was the father of Klock's sister's illegitimate child. Klock says he ordered Holden away, and when the latter threatened him, shot at him to scare him away.

The grand jury found no reason to hold him for trial and he was released from custody.

Robert Klock Smith  
1859-1931

Last month I did an article on a lumber town that was know as Klock's Mill. The Lumber Mill, owned by R.H. Klock, was on the Ottawa River in Mattawa, Canada. The mill is gone now. The land was flooded with the building of the Holden Dam about fifty years ago and little remains Klock's Mill today except a few pictures.

Last week I found an article on Robert Klock Smith on the Internet, I search the net all the time for genealogy

information and for interesting stories for this Newsletter. I found an article about Robert Klock Smith. The article was in the Manitoba Agricultural Hall of Fame, Brandon, Manitoba, Canada. Roll of Honour II. I checked my family tree to see if I had a Robert Klock Smith. I had Robert H. Klock that owned the lumber mill. ( Klock's Mill ) I checked back and Robert H. Klock father's name was Robert Klock. Robert was married to Catharina Starhring and they had two children, Maria and Ira Klock. After Catharina died he married Elizabeth Bell and they had three children, Robert H., Nancy and James. I do not know who Nancy married so I am assuming she married a Smith and Nancy Klock was his mother.

According to the article Robert Klock Smith was born in Ontario in 1859. His father died when Robert was thirteen years old. Robert moved to Aylmer, Quebec to work for his uncle at the lumber mill. Robert was a bookkeeper and telegraph operator. (Klock Mill did have a Train Station, which had a Stationmaster and a telegraph office.) While working at lumber mill, Robert became fluent in the French Language.

In 1882 he moved to Winnipeg and then to the Maskawata district, where he filed on the CPR quarter. He worked in the woods at Rainy River and Portage La Prairie, built a house and became a farmer. In 1889 he married Margaret Smith. Robert and Margaret had seven children, five boys and two girls.

In 1903, Robert was one of thirteen farmers selected by the Immigration Minister, Clifford Sifton, to travel to Britain to encourage immigration. Robert had one of the first horse powered threshing machines. Later he bought two steam engine machines and traveled the area with his machine, harvesting crops. He had the first gas engine threshing machines in the District. According to the article he was instrumental in forming the Oak Lake Agricultural Society and served as secretary for many years. He was chairman of the local School Board. Robert assisted in building the Ryerson Methodist (United) Church. Robert also kept a diary on the weather, politics, and on farm life in the mid 1880's to 1931.

Now Robert Klock Smith's name is on the Honour Roll of the Agricultural Hall of Fame in Manitoba, Canada.
