Russell Klock

Russell Klock, 65, Fort Plain RD 1, died last Thursday at the Amsterdam Memorial Hospital where he had been a patient for four and a half weeks.

He was born in the Town of Minden, ~~May~~²⁻²⁷ 7, 1904, the son of Emmett and Mary J. Tinkler Klock, and had lived his entire life in the area where he owned and operated the family farm south of St. Johnsville on the River road. He was married to Mildred Harrington in 1931.

He was a member of the United Methodist Church in St. Johnsville, a member for 44 years of St. Johnsville Lodge No. 611, F. and A.M., the Montgomery County Extension Service; a member of the Town of Minden Republican Committee, and a former member and past president of the Board of Education of St. Johnsville Central School District which he served for 23 years.

He is survived by his wife and seven daughters, Mrs. Edward Fettinger and Mrs. Kenneth Van Schaick, Fort Plain; Mrs. Ronald Emery, Fort Plain RD; Mrs. James Hernigle and Mrs. Albert Hernigle, both of Randall; Mrs. Harry Ford, Loudonville, and Mrs. Peter Wilson, Pittsburgh, Pa.; a son, Peter Klock, at home; 20 grandchildren; two brothers, Irvin Klock and Emmett Klock, Fort Plain RD 1; several nieces and nephews.

Funeral services were held 2 p.m. Sunday at the Lull Funeral Home in St. Johnsville, with the Rev. Durward Winner, pastor of the St. Johnsville United Methodist Church, officiating. Interment will be made in the spring in the Fort Plain cemetery.
